The mission of the Academy of Construction Technologies (ACT) is to develop a well-trained workforce in the construction industry. This will be accomplished by improving the image of construction careers and by sponsoring a youth/pre-apprenticeship program in Orange, Osceola and Seminole schools. The Academy of Construction Technologies (ACT) was founded in 1992 and is a non-profit tax-exempt organization. The ACT office is located at Mid Florida Technical School in Orlando, Florida. ACT is a partnership of the Central Florida construction industry contractors and trade associations representing both union and non-union trade associations. ACT works closely with Orange, Osceola, and Seminole school districts to promote constructions as a career, but also to furnish students with the opportunity to develop lifelong rewarding skills.

One of the means a graduating ACT student has to financially help themselves continue their training into an adult apprenticeship program is by becoming a recipient of the **Spencer D. Clark Scholarship**. The scholarship award is restricted for post-secondary educational programs that are construction related. The scholarship is limited to one candidate for each county of Orange, Osceola and Seminole. The scholarship was originally established in May 1998 to recognize outstanding ACT students that are completing the ACT program and graduating from high school. In October 2000, the scholarship was named in memory of Spencer D. Clark. Clark was named the scholarship recipient in May 1999, an Edgewater High School student from Orange County. He was especially interested and dedicated to the construction industry and had completed the ACT program. His post secondary education continued in construction and he worked full time in the industry pursuing his lifelong career. Spencer D. Clark exemplified the qualities of an outstanding young man, a student, and an employee in the industry for which he cared. He selected his education and career path to follow a devoted interest and love.
